Lynn will take us through a recently completed capacity building strategy for early childhood development in off-diagonal neighbourhoods – that is, neighbourhoods showing contradictory socioeconomic and developmental indicators. Lynn will use empirical and social data to describe this community-based project and discuss how community action research can enhance early learning to improve local health outcomes.
